4. Discussion Items

4.1 School District Updates

➤ Jordan School District

**Commission Member Maxwell** stated during the last Redistricting Commission meeting, the Commission voted to ask the Jordan School District's Board of Education some questions about boundaries, which the district responded to.

**Mr. Scott Festin**, Planning & Enrollment, Jordan School District, submitted Jordan School Districts' final map and reviewed the changes that were made to the current boundaries. Yesterday, it was brought to the Jordan School District that District #7 was outside of the 10 percent population variance, and he reviewed minor tweaks that were done to fix that. The final map maintains the spirit of the option the Jordan School District Board of Directors unanimously approved.

A motion was made by Commission Member Bentley, seconded by

Commission Member Andersen, to forward the Jordan School District's map to the Council, with the Commission's recommendation of adoption. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

➤ Canyons School District

**Commission Member Maxwell** read the following transmittal letter he received from the Canyons School District, dated November 10, 2021:

*Attached is the GIS map the Canyons Board of Education recommends for your consideration in the redistricting process. The recommendation was approved by the Board in a meeting on November 9, 2021, by a unanimous vote.*

**Ms. Emily LaMunyon**, Surveyor's Office, reviewed the map submitted by the Canyons School District, which included the population numbers for each district, as well as a map of the existing boundaries and a map of the existing boundaries with population numbers.

**Ms. Charlotte Kuhn**, Election Division, asked that the Clerk's Office and Surveyor's Office have the ability to adjust the boundaries where necessary.

A motion was made by Commission Member Maxwell, seconded by Commission Member Chatwin, to forward the Canyons School District's map to the Council, with the Commission's recommendation of adoption; and to allow the Clerk's Office and the Surveyor's Office to align the school district maps as necessary so as not to divide any houses. The motion carried by a unanimous vote.

**5. Other Committee Business**

**Commission Member Maxwell** asked if the Commission had any other business. It did not disband during its 10-year term, but he could not imagine the need for a new districting. He also asked if it could meet socially.

**Mr. Jason Rose**, Deputy District Attorney, stated the Commission has forwarded all the maps to the appropriate body. If it needed to meet again, he would let it know. The Commission could meet socially, provided it did not conduct business.
